



Dear Riders and Families:

Thank you for your interest in Maryland Therapeutic Riding and the services we offer. The winter session is off to a fantastic start, and we are putting our beautiful indoor arena to good use! Due to a substantially high interest in the Spring 2010 session, we will be conducting early registration. A deposit of \$50 will hold your spot. Registration is on a first come-first serve basis, so please submit all your information, with your deposit as soon as possible.

The Spring session will begin on March 15th and run for eight weeks until May 8th. Registration for the Spring session will be conducted from January 15th until February 20th. You may submit your registration form by fax, phone, or stop by the office. Payment for the spring session is due in full by March 6th, 2010. Clients in the Hippotherapy program should contact their therapists directly to confirm their spring schedule.

It is a requirement of our accrediting agency, North American Riding for the Handicapped Association (NARHA) that all riders submit complete paperwork on an annual basis. This standard is regardless of how often an individual has ridden at MTR during 2009. All of the rider paperwork is available at MTR's website: www.horsethatheal.org.
